

**ALL ROADS LEAD TO TYGER VALLEY (SPEND & WIN)
GENERAL COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS
1 March to 31 March 2026**

1. By entering this competition, you accept and agree to the following terms and conditions which will govern the competition. Furthermore, you verify that you are unaware of any reason legally prohibiting you from entering this competition and, if the competition requires the submission of photographs, artwork, or images of people, or of anything else that requires consent, that you have the necessary consent and authority to do so, if required. Any entrant who contravenes these rules may be disqualified from the competition.
2. The Promoters of this competition are Tyger Valley Centre.
3. The competition will run from **1 March to 31 March 2026**. Entries after these dates or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
4. You may only enter this competition if you are a citizen and permanent resident of South Africa, 18 years of age or over. The winner will be required to present a valid South African ID to accept the prize. It is the winner's responsibility to collect the prize from Tyger Valley Centre Management.
5. **To enter the competition:**

Spend R500 (five hundred rand) or more at any Tyger Valley Centre store as a once-off purchase. All Tyger Run participants receive a bonus entry into the competition.

1. Complete your till slip with your contact details on the back (Name, Surname, Contact Number, and Email Address).
2. Drop your completed slip in any of the Tyger Valley branded entry boxes located at Centre Management, Information Desk or in front of Pandora or Kauai.

By entering, you stand a chance to win a Tyger Valley Centre Voucher in one of the following categories: **Gold, Silver, or Bronze.**

GOLD

1 Winner of a Tyger Valley Voucher to the value of R10 000

SILVER

1 Winner of a Tyger Valley Voucher to the value of R5 000

BRONZE

1 Winner of a Tyger Valley Voucher to the value of R3 000

6. You may only use the Tyger Valley Centre till slip (from a Tyger Valley Tenant) once to enter the competition. Entrants will not be able to accumulate Tyger Valley till slips from more than one tenant to make up the value of a R500 purchase. Only once-off purchase slips to the value of **R500** will qualify as a valid entry.
7. There is no restriction on the number of times you may enter the competition. One valid slip per entry will be accepted.
8. There will be one winner selected per category from the competition entries received.
